'Fixing New Lawn Memorials to the NAMM Code of Working Practice'

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is designed to prepare candidates for the successful completion of the BRAMM Fixer Licence test and will include a comprehensive study of the NAMM Code of Working Practice and how it relates to the new British Standard BS8415.

An in-depth theoretical induction as to what will be expected on the BFL test day will include Health & Safety aspects leading to the generation of professional Risk Assessment documentation. The course also includes a practical 'hands on' demonstration and guidance as to what will be expected on the BFL test day and provide a comprehensive understanding of accredited ground anchors and how they are applied etc.

Candidates will be responsible for providing their own personal protective clothing/equipment for the day and these must include ear defenders, goggles, gloves and protective footwear.
